



St Michaels O35FC - World Cup 2010 Tipping Competition

RULES

The Competition

This competition is unlike any other.

It is a real test of football knowledge, requiring you to pick not only the 64 world cup games but also the 40 St Michaels O35FC games (for 2, 2R, 3, 3R, 4, 4R, O45 and Women) during the period of the World Cup. There are bonus points for picking the correct scores, as well as tournament points for most goals etc.

You will need to lodge a series of tipping sheets by email. So that you have up to date information, the tip sheets (other than tipsheet 1) will be distributed quite close to the first of the games to which they relate. This means you will need to turn them around quickly.

Prize pool distribution

Tipsheet 1 - Round 1, games 1 to 16 (Saturday 12 – Thursday 17 June)

Tipsheet 1 covers 16 world cup games and 8 St Michaels games. You will be asked to pick win, lose or draw for **1 point**.

The deadline for this tipsheet (and the tournament points sheet – see below) is 11pm, Friday 11 June 2010.

Tipsheet 2 – Round 1, games 17 to 32 (Thursday 17 – Tuesday 22 June)

Tipsheet 2 will also cover 16 world cup games and 8 St Michaels games.

The deadline for this tipsheet will be 3:30am Wednesday, 17 June. It will be distributed a few days before then.

Again, you will be asked to pick win, lose or draw for **1 point**.

Tipsheet 3 – Round 1, games 33 to 48 (Wednesday 23 – Sunday 27 June)

Tipsheet 3 will also cover 16 work cup games and 8 St Michaels games.

The deadline for this tipsheet will be 11pm Tuesday, 22 June. It will be distributed a few days before then.

Again, you will be asked to pick win, lose or draw for **1 point**.

Tipsheet 4 - Round of 16, games 49 to 52 (Sunday 27 – Monday 28 June)

Tipsheet 4 will cover 4 of the round of 16 games.

You will be asked to pick the winners for **2 points each**.

The deadline for this tipsheet will be 11pm Saturday, 26 June. It will be distributed on Thursday, 24 June.

Tipsheet 5 – Round of 16, games 53 to 56 (Tuesday 29 – Wednesday 30 June)

Tipsheet 5 will cover the remaining 4 round of 16 games.

You will be asked to pick the winners for **2 points each**.

The deadline for this tipsheet will be 11pm Monday, 28 June. It will be distributed on the morning of Monday, 28 June, so you will need to turn it around quickly.

Tipsheet 6- Quarter Finals, games 57 to 60 (Saturday 3 and Sunday 4 July)

Tipsheet 6 will cover the 4 Quarter Finals, as well as the 8 St Michaels games on 3 and 4 July. These games are worth **3 points each**.

The deadline for this tipsheet will be 11pm, Friday, 2 July. It will be distributed as soon as possible after completion of the round of 16 games.

Tipsheet 7 - Semi Finals, games 61 and 62 (Wednesday 7 and Thursday 8 July)

Tipsheet 7 will cover the semi finals. You will be asked to pick the winners for **5 points each**.

The deadline for this tipsheet will be 3:30am Wednesday, 7 July. It will be distributed as soon as possible after completion of the quarter finals.

Tipsheet 8 - Third Place Playoff and Final, games 63 and 64

Tipsheet 8 will cover the third place playoff and the Final.

The Third Place Playoff is on Sunday 11 July. A further 8 St Michaels games will be played on 10 and 11 July. Each of these 9 games will be worth **4 points**.

The Final is on Monday, 12 July. You will be asked to pick the winner for **10 points**.

The deadline for this tipsheet will be 3.30am Sunday, 11 July. It will be distributed as soon as possible after completion of the semi finals.

Pick the Score points

For **all** games you will also be asked to pick the score for bonus points.

The score does not include penalties. The score you need to pick is therefore the score at the end of normal play (whether that be at the end of 90 minutes or extra time). You can, therefore, pick a draw.

Some scores are harder to pick than others, so the bonus points are:

1 point – for picking a score of 1-0, 2-0 or 2-1

2 points – for picking a score of 0-0 or 1-1

3 points – for picking any other score

Tournament points

You may also answer the Tournament Points sheet for further points. It is attached and must be lodged with your first tipping sheet.

Pseudonyms

Please nominate a pseudonym by which you will be known (Sir Aidan Ferguson, The Pope, Bulldozer, Ritchie McCaw, etc).

I will publish regular updates of the points table for the competition and will use the pseudonyms.
